ASSOCIATE PSYCHOLOGY TRAINING DIRECTOR

General Description:

Adheres to the spirit of the Salud mission statement while performing assigned duties. Responsible for coordination and supervision within the Psychology Training Program under guidance by the Director of Integrated Behavioral Health and Psychology Training.

Reporting Relationship:

The Associate Psychology Training Director will report directly to the Director of Integrated Behavioral Health and Psychology Training.

Supervision Exercised:

Supervises trainees in the Psychology Training Program (to include postdoctoral fellows, interns, and practicum students).

Duties and Responsibilities (including but not limited to the following):

Administrative

- Provide individual supervision to postdoctoral fellows
- Provide supervision of supervision to postdoctoral fellows
- Provide group supervision to all psychology trainees
- Review and sign off on notes of supervisees and their supervisees
- Provide orientation to trainees regarding the Salud system, the Salud model, and the electronic health record
- Coordinate posting position openings, receiving and reviewing applications, scheduling and coordinating interviews, etc

Clinical

- Provide clinical services according to Salud's model (1-2 days per week)
- Maintain documentation according to Colorado standards

Other

- Build and maintain relationships with local academic institutions and other training programs
- Restructure and create didactics for psychology training program

Position Qualifications:

- Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical Psychology or Counseling Psychology
- Licensed as a Psychologist in Colorado
- Experience in integrated primary care (other health psychology experience accepted)
- Experience working in multidisciplinary setting utilizing a team approach

- Experience working with diverse populations (ethnicity, socioeconomic status, LGBT, age, IQ, SPMI, physical disability, medically fragile)
- Experience in treatment of patients with Axis I and II disorders
- Familiarity with psychopharmacology, medical terminology, and medical illness
- Strong background in assessment
- Experience providing clinical (and preferably administrative) supervision
- Experience in working from an evidence-based practice approach
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Critical thinking skills, with demonstrated ability to solve complex problems

Preferred Competencies:

- Bilingual (fluent in English and Spanish)
- Teaching experience
- Completion of APA-accredited internship
- At least 3 years post-licensure as a psychologist

Salary and Benefits:
